


- 1. All 5FM competitions are conducted in accordance with the provisions of Section 54 (1) of the Lotteries Amendment Act (46 of 2001).
- 2. 5FM competitions are open to all South Africans, unless otherwise stated. Competitions are not open to employees, agencies, prize sponsors or contractors of 5FM, the SABC or any person directly or indirectly involved in the organisation or running of the competition, or their immediate family members.
- 3. No person may enter the same or any other competition hosted partly or in whole by 5FM within three (3) months of winning the same or any other competition hosted partly or in whole by 5FM.
- 4. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 5. Prizes other than cash are not transferable, cannot be deferred or exchanged for cash and are not negotiable.
- 6. Winners use and accept prizes at their own risk. 5FM, the SABC and the prize sponsors (and/or their respective agencies) cannot be held responsible for any accident, injury, or loss of property experienced as a result of winning, accepting and/or utilising prizes won.
- 7. Prizes not collected/claimed within 6 months of being won will be disposed of at 5FM's discretion.
- 8. By entering 5FM competitions, entrants agree to adhere to competition rules and regulations, details of which entrants declare themselves conversant with.
- 9. Any violation or attempt to violate any of the above rules will result in the immediate disqualification of the transgressor.
- 10. 5FM may disqualify a transgressor for entry into any other 5FM competitions, for a period deemed appropriate by 5FM Management.
- 11. 5FM and the prize sponsors reserve the right to cancel the competition at any time, if deemed necessary in their opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of their control and shall not be liable in anyway whatsoever to entrants in such event for any cause or action whatsoever.

Such altered rules and prizes shall become effective immediately after being altered or on such date as may be determined by 5FM. No entrant shall have any recourse against 5FM as a result of the alterations of the rules or prizes.

2. Addendum:

- 1. In addition to 5FM's standard Competition Terms and Conditions, the below conditions also apply for the Keep Up competition
- 2. How many keep ups can you do? 5FM is looking for the listener who can keep the ball up by using their foot. It does not matter which ball the listener will use; long as the listener can keep it up without letting it fall to the ground.
- 3. The competition will take place daily from 21 April 2020 until 30 April 2020.
- 4. The competition will take place once per show; on The Roger Goode Show 06:00-09:00 and The Afternoon Drive 15:00-18:00- weekdays. On the weekends, it will be twice per show on Xtra Loud Mornings 07:00-10:00 only.
- 5. To participate in the competition:
 - a. contestants will need to be 18 years or older.
 - Listeners will need to send 5FM any ball emoji, to the 5FM Whatsapp phone number: 082 550 5151.
 - c. Contestants will be chosen at random from sent Whatsapp messages. Only contestants who participated on air will be considered for the competition.
- 6. 5FM will call the contestant back and put them live on air to do as many Keep Ups as they can.
- 7. The contestants will have two chances; the best round of the two will be slotted on to the leader board.
 - a. For confirmation of the Keep Ups; all contestants will need to film their Keep Ups while they are live on air. This can be done either by the contestant themselves or by another person who is with the contestant at the time.

- b. The contestant will need to send the video to 5FM on the 5FM's Whatsapp number: 082 550 5151. By sending the videos to 5FM, all contestants thereby give 5FM full discretion to utilize their videos on 5FM's platforms with no reimbursements and surrender all rights.
- 8. Each show will keep a daily leader board to see which contestant will be representing the show in the final.
- 9. On 29th April 2020, three finalists will be selected. The contestants with the highest Keep Up per show will become a finalist.
- 10. The three finalists will be called on the 30th April 2020 live on The Roger Goode Show. Each finalist will again need to show who can score the most Keep Ups Live on Air.
 - a. The finalists will have two chances; the best round of the two will be the final score.
 - b. For confirmation of the Keep Ups; all three finalist will need to film their Keep Ups while they are live on air. This can be done either by the finalist themselves or by another person who is with then at the time.
 - c. The finalists will need to send the video to 5FM on the 5FM's Whatsapp number: 082 550 5151. By sending the videos to 5FM, all contestants thereby give 5FM full discretion to utilize their videos on 5FM's platforms with no reimbursements and surrender all rights.
- 11. The finalists with the most Keep Ups will win the competition.
- 12. Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 13. The prize of the competition will be a soccer ball signed by 5FM's Sports Readers: Duran Collett, Robbie Kruse and Jude van Wyk.
- 14. The winner will be announced on-air during the above-mentioned show.
- 15. Prizes are not transferrable for cash or any other item of value.
